Natwarlal Maniklal Dalal College of Arts, Commerce, Law and Management is Pioneering college of Gondia Education Society (GES) established in the Year 1958 by the great visionary and philanthropist Late Shri Manoharbai Patel Starting with two under graduation programs of B.A. and B.Com.. The institution has now expanded to multiple UG and PG courses. At present it has B.A., B.Com., B.B.A., B.C.C.A, M.A. in Political Science, History, Economics, English, M.Com., M.B.A. and L.L.B. programs conducted in affiliation with Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur.

N. M. D. College, Gondia is a co-education college and in the academic session 2020-2021 it has total 2741 students among which there are 1510 girls and 1231 boys. The institution has completed three cycles of accreditation and accredited with "B" grade in the third cycle by National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore. In the last couple of decades the college has gone through a sea change in the academic pursuits as well as infrastructural developments under the Patronage of Hon'ble Shri Praful Patel, Patron GES, Hon'ble Smt. Varsh Patel, President GES, Hon'ble Shri Rajendraji Jain, Secretary GES and Hon'ble Shri Nikhil Jain, Director GES.

Apart from its curricular achievements the institution is also known for it's co-curricular activities. It's Units of National Service Scheme, National Cadets corps, Continuous Education and Cultural Activities provide adequate platforms to the students to exploit their potential for their all round development Looking at the vibrant and enthusiastic participation of the students in N.S.S. the university has given the institution two units in which 200 volunteers are enrolled every year. The N.C.C. unit or the

institution comes under 4 Maharashtra Battalion, Nagpur and it has 108 cadets in which there are 72 boy and 36 girl cadets. The college has a authorized research centre to per sue doctoral research in the faculties of Political Science, Commerce and economics.

The College has an auditorium with 550 seating capacity and a seminar hall with 200 seating capacity to organize seminars and conferences. In spite of being an Arts and Commerce College the College has five computer labs with 159 computer systems for students of various disciplines. The college has a huge central library with more than one lakh books. The college library has been completely computerized using M-OPAC service for the students. It has subscribed to number of N-List journals and university remote access for research purpose. The college is also using 2.01 fully automated LIBMAN software for data collection, information and other services of the library.

Owing to the prevalence of pandemic Covid-19 during the academic session 2020-2021 the college conducted majority of it's classes through online platforms as per the instructions of the parent university, State government and district authorities. During the period of pandemic the faculties developed member of ICT based teaching learning methods and materials for the students. Under the guidance of Principal, Dr. Sharda I. Mahajan the college performed it's level best in it's academic and administrative pursuits during the difficult times of pandemic Covid-19.
