TEACHERS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT

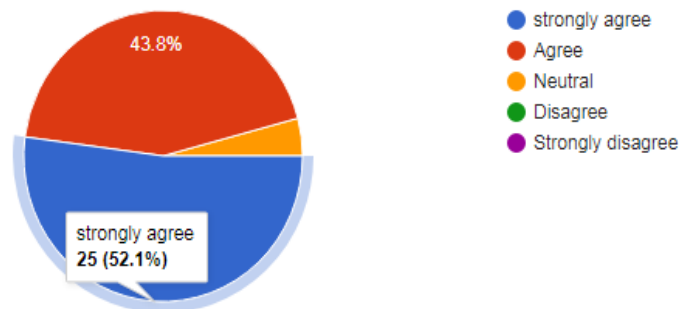
