- We have randomly selected 15 forms of each faculty. 12 questions were there for each faculty and we selected 15 forms therefore, responses were divided by 180.
- There are four scales for valuation:-
  - 0 < Average > 1
  - 1 ≤ Good > 2
  - 2 ≤ Very Good > 3
  - 3 ≤ Excellent > 4
- Conclusion of question no. Which is related to library facility is that mostly students agreed and are satisfied with library facility.
- Conclusion of question no. 13 which is related to administration work is that mostly students agreed and are satisfied with administration work.
- Conclusion of question no. 14 which is related to suggestions from students are forwarded to Head of the institution for necessary action.
