04. To inculcate an understanding of modern scenario of 21st century and need to develop skills to survive in this competitive world.






The practice: Distribution of clothes and necessary goods are provided by the Institute through the collection from various sources who voluntarily wants to contribute in this practice. This practice includes -

- Rehabilitation of child beggars



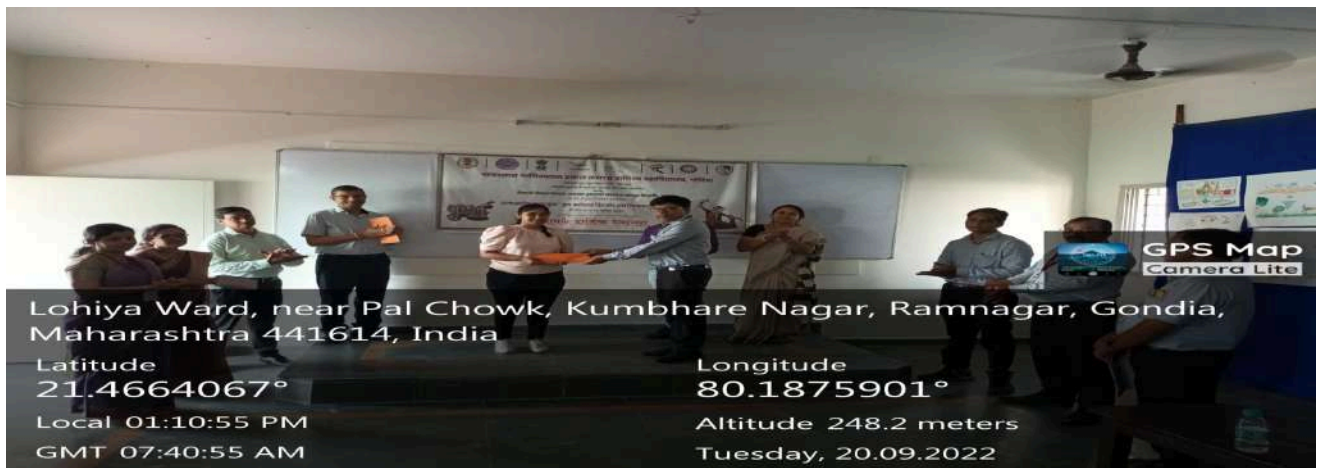

The online monitoring committee ensures that the report of the class is submitted by each and every teacher after his/her period. The data was collected through Google Form. A uniform and structured procedure was adopted by the committee to ensure the transparency in the record system of the online and offline classes. And the pattern of online and offline classes was adopted to ensure regularity in classes. The reporting of the same everyday at 5:00 pm. was submitted to the Chairman of the committee by the Prof. Incharge. The faculty leaves and holidays were excluded from the maintenance of records.
