INTER LIBRARY AGREEMENT FOR SHARING LIBRARY RESOURCES FOR VISUALLY CHALLENGED STAFF AND STUDENTS

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for

COOPERATION, PROMOTION AND NETWORKING OF INSTITUTIONAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL FOR STANDARDIZATION OF POLICIES & PROCEDURES

The Parties intend by this MOU to establish a mutually beneficial partnership.

This MOU will address the basic relationship, rules and responsibilities of the Parties but leaves for later agreement the more precise terms that will constitute the substance of the partnership.

1. PURPOSE: -

The Parties enter in to this MOU for the primary purpose of Co-operation. The IL agreement is on reciprocal basis between both libraries. The requesting library will bear all responsibilities in case of forward/return, delivery/postage cost, overdue, fines, security of and loss or damage to the borrowed Braille Books and Audio CDs.

2. AUTHORITY: -

The MOU will primarily be governed by Principal of the College and the Secretary, 'NAB Activity Center', Ganesh Nagar, Gondia.

3. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES: -

The Parties intend to undertake the following activities pursuant to this MOU.

3.1 Parties agree to:

3.1.1 Share information with confidentiality as the main clause which does not harm the participating organization.

3.1.2 Create better working environment and better academic practices through joint working.

3.1.3 Create easy and better documentation procedures.

3.2 The Parties agree to:

3.2.1 Work in collaboration for tenure of 5 years from the date of signing.

- * The lending libraries policy and procedure must be adhered to.
- * While it is understood that the libraries in house or regular individual user shall receive priority in borrowing privileges the lending library shall endeavor to fulfill the request of the Borrowing Library.
- * The Borrowing Library should ensure that the due date is observed and that all prosecution is taken to ensure the security of the items on loan and that no damage is done to the materials.
- * The signed agreement by both the parties will be effective and binding to them and will be in force till its agreed time duration.

4. TERMINATION: -






Unless terminated by a written agreement executed by either Party MoU shall remain in effect.

And

INDIA POST PAYMENTS BANK LIMITED, a public limited company wholly owned by the Government of India through Department of Post under Ministry of Communication and set up under the Companies Act, 2013, and the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 as a Payments Bank under the Department of Posts and in line with relevant guidelines of the Reserve Bank of India, having its Registered & Corporate Office at Post Office, Speed Post Centre Building, Market Road, New Delhi – 110001, Circle Office, at First Floor, Dadar Head Post Office, Dadar, Mumbai- 400014 & Branch Office at Gondia Head Post Office, Gondia-441601, Maharashtra (hereinafter referred to as "IPPB" or "Bank" which expression shall, unless repugnant or contrary to the context, include its successors and permitted assigns) on the SECOND PART

WHEREAS

NMD College has agreed to enter into an MOU with IPPB to recognize and conduct various Internship/Industrial/Vocational Trainings/Faculty Development Programmes for the students and faculties of NMD College, On campus/Off campus.

AND WHEREAS

The parties have had preliminary discussions in this matter and have ascertained areas of broad consensus. The parties have, therefore, agreed now to include in writing these areas of consensus under this Memorandum of Understanding.

AND WHEREAS

IPPB is engaged in Banking and Financial services and provides internship as per needs.

Now this Memorandum of Understanding witnesses that:

I. OBJECTIVES:

The following are the objectives of the MoU between the two institutions:

- (a) To provide exposure to students to do internship in scheduled commercial bank.
- (b) To support students in getting hands-on training in real time banking exposure.
- (c) To conduct various financial literacy camps and seminars to educate student and faculties.
- (d) To provide opportunities for students to showcase their talents.

II. SCOPE OF MOU:

To achieve the above objectives outlined in the preceding paragraphs both parties agree to discharge the following responsibilities.

III. IPPB SHALL;

- (a) Provide opportunities to the students, researchers and teachers to develop their financial competencies by offering internships, and other project opportunities.
- (b) Organise workshops, seminars, training programs etc in collaboration with the college.
- (c) Facilitate students to get the right exposure to hone their skills through interaction with professionals.
- (d) Support students to take up projects based on the internship.
- (e) Assist in the evaluation of the students' performance in the training experience.
- (f) Sign the weekly work report to verify the student's attendance.

IV. NMD COLLEGE SHALL;

- (a) Identify students and promote them to attend internships and trainings.
- (b) Help students to get acquainted with the banking environment.
- (c) Encourage them to participate in the programs and extension activities of the IPPB.
- (d) Provide the platform/venue for the activities of the IPPB.
- (e) Encourage the students and staff to avail the benefits and services offered by IPPB.

IMPLEMENTATION AUTHORITY:

On behalf of the IPPB, The Chief Manager & Circle Head (Maharashtra) and on behalf of NMD College, the Principal shall act as the implementing authority, for operating the various provisions of



this MoU on behalf of their respective organizations. All formal communications shall be exchanged only through the representatives nominated by each party.

V. GENERAL TERMS OF MOU:

- (a) Both the parties agree that no action/ failure on the part of either party to act with the above MOU will not give rise to serve as the basis for any claim, obligation, or liability on either side.
- (b) The facilities/ support offered by the IPPB could vary or be strengthened/ amended from time to time as mutually agreed and new courses could be added in consultation between the two parties.

VI. VALIDITY OF THIS MOU:

This MOU is valid initially for a period of 01 Year starting from the date of signing and can be renewed for a further period on mutually acceptable terms & conditions.

VII. FINANCIAL CONSIDERATION:

- The NMD College and the IPPB each agree to bear their own costs associated with this MoU and that no payment is required by either NMD College or the IPPB to the other party.
- The IPPB is not required to reimburse or to provide any kind of Stipend/financial assistance to the Students or Faculty for any internship or training etc pursuant to this MoU.

VIII. REPRESENTATION AND WARRANTIES

Both parties to this MOU represent and warrant as follows:

- a) Parties are duly organized and validly existing under the laws of India.
- b) Parties has the full power of and authority to execute, deliver and perform its obligations under this MOU and carry out the transactions contemplated hereby
- c) Parties have financial standing and capacity to undertake activities envisaged in accordance with the terms of the MOU.
- d) This MOU constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation, enforceable against it in accordance with the terms hereof, and its obligations under this MOU will be legally valid, binding and enforceable obligations against it in accordance with the terms hereof
- e) It is subject to the laws of India, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waives any immunity in any jurisdiction in respect of this MOU or matters arising there under including any obligation, liability or responsibility,

X. COMMERCIALS

This MOU is only an arrangement between both the Parties and hence no commercials are involved under this MOU

XI. INDEMNIFICATION

- a) Each party to this MOU agrees to bear the individual responsibility for any third-party claims, demands, proceedings, prosecutions, or actions against either party to this MOU, arising out of and as a result of any callous, negligent, deficient action or omission by the other party to this MOU and shall indemnify the respective party against all losses and damages suffered including expenses incurred by them while defending the claim (Inclusive of Legal Expenses) in any court as a result of any such claim, demands, proceedings, prosecutions or actions.
- b) Either party to this MOU undertakes to indemnify, protect and save the other party against all claims, losses, costs, damages, expenses, legal suits and other proceedings, resulting from any act, omission, conduct, failure or malfunctioning of the delivery of services, negligence or deficiency of services under this MoU
- c) The maximum aggregate liability of either Party with respect to any breach of terms, under or relating to this MOU will in no event exceed the actual loss or damage or claim amount, incurred by the concerned Party.
- d) The Parties have agreed that this clause XII shall survive the termination of this MOU.

XII. ARBITRATION

In the event of any question, dispute or difference arising under this MOU or in connection therewith (except as to the matters, the decision to which is specifically provided under this MOU), the same shall be referred to arbitrator appointed by both the parties and a third arbitrator (Umpire) appointed by mutual consent of both the arbitrators appointed by each party. The third arbitrator(Umpire) shall preside over the arbitration proceedings. The proceedings of Arbitration shall be Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 in English and the place of arbitration proceedings shall be Delhi.

The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties to the MOU. Subject to the aforesaid, Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules made there under, any modification thereof for the time being in force shall be deemed to apply to the arbitration proceeding under this clause.




